The risks include a higher probability of accidents, interpersonal conflicts, unprofessional behaviour, reduced productivity, lower staff morale, absenteeism, and health-related financial costs. It is important for workers to be aware of the dangers of drug and alcohol use and the potential impacts on their work.
